## KYA Minimum Relay Qualifying Standards for 2022 AAU Junior Olympic Games

Minimum time standards must be met for each relay team in order for the team to be considered for entry into the National Championships. This is regardless of whether the team qualifies by place of finish (top 4) at the National Qualifying Meet in Knoxville, TN. These standards must be met by or at the National Qualifier. The relay standards are based on the time that represents the 50th percentile finish for relay teams in the 2018 AAU National Championships. In other words, if there were 44 teams entered in the girls 9 year old 4x100, our minimum qualifying standard for this group would be the finishing time for the 22nd place team. Low Entries indicates that last year the entries were so low we could not determine a cut-off and would need to be evaluated on a case by case basis.
